

Ena Noël Award 2024

THE IBBY AUSTRALIA ENCOURAGEMENT AWARD FOR CHILDREN'S LITERATURE

ENTRY DETAILS:

• There will be two awards from 2024 – one for author, and one for illustrator.

The award has been presented from 1994 to 2022 to either a young developing Australian writer or illustrator. In 2024, to celebrate the thirtieth anniversary of the award's inception, the IBBY Australia Committee announces a change, in that two biennial awards will be presented – one to an author and one to an illustrator. This is in recognition of the importance of visual literacy and the role that illustration plays in complementing the textual narrative in children's and young people's literature.

- Books for the 2024 award should be submitted by 30th November 2023.
- The nominated creator must be under the age of 35 at the time the title (or titles) for which they are nominated was published.
- Only books published between 1st July 2021–30th June 2023 are eligible.
- Four copies of the book must be submitted to the coordinator.
- The creator author/illustrator that is being nominated must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident of Australia.
- •The book must have been published in print form in Australia.
